Job Responsibilities:

Facility and Equipment Management

- Inspect vehicles for mechanical items and safety issues and perform preventative maintenance
- Clean and maintain interior and exterior of the trucks as well as JEPCA shop

Safety and Compliance

- To operate any truck and pumping units in the safest fashion possible
- Ability to deliver bulk products in a safe manner while following Koch Fuel Products Inc. standards
- Ability to follow all CPPI safety requirements and all other safety measures outlined in your policy manual, and truck handbook.
- Comply with all legislations including laws of the road, Alberta transportation, weights and measures
- Report defects, accidents or violations

Operational and Managerial Duties

- Receive and follow oral or written orders from Site Manager
- Your attitude must always be improving your methods and systems of handling the maintenance, trucks, equipment and products.
- Transport finished goods and raw materials over land to and from manufacturing plants or retail and distribution centers
- Ability to switch between trucks and delivery of different products

Requirements:

- Class 3 Drivers License;
- Strong problem solving skills;
- Accountable, dependable, and flexible;
- Exceptional attention to detail and quality of work;
- Good organizational, time management and prioritizing skills;
- Able to demonstrate a positive attitude and strong work ethic;
- Able to handle multiple priorities and tasks;
- Experience with customer service preferred.

Working Conditions:

- Able to drive and sit for long periods;
- Able to follow specific directions;
- May spend long hours in intense concentration which requires attention to detail and high levels of accuracy; and
- Required to meet a number of deadlines which may cause stress.
- May need to lift or move heavy objects
- Ability to use a broom and/or snow shovel on a daily basis
- Ability to be under and on top of large trucks while doing truck maintenance
