Job Responsibilities:

Facility and Equipment Management

- Inspect vehicles for mechanical items and safety issues, including performing preventative maintenance
- Service trucks, including oil changes and greasing
- Clean and maintain the interior and exterior of the trucks as well as cleaning up your work area in JEPCA shop after every occasion in the shop
- Able to clean and maintain the Jepca Shop during periods of inactivity
- Shuttle trucks and trailers between the yard/warehouse to the shop and other facilities
- Your attitude must always be towards improving your methods and systems of handling maintenance, trucks, equipment, and products

Safety and Compliance

- To operate any truck and pumping units in the safest fashion possible
- Ability to deliver bulk products in a safe manner while following JEPCA Holdings safety standards and government regulations, which are outlined in the Jepca Policy Manual
- Comply with all legislation, including laws of the road, Alberta transportation, and weights and measures
- Report all defects, accidents, or violations in accordance with company policies
- Follow all Federal Hours of Service and Electronic Logging Device requirements, which may include you spending extra or unplanned time in a Sleeper Berth

Operational Duties

- Receive and follow oral or written orders from the Dispatcher or Manager
- Transport finished goods and raw materials over land to and from manufacturing plants or retail and distribution centers
- The ability to switch between trucks and delivery of different products

Requirements:

- Class 1 Drivers License
- Fluid Hauling Experience
- Strong problem-solving skills
- Accountable, dependable, and flexible
- Exceptional attention to detail and quality of work
- Good organizational, time management and prioritizing skills
- Able to demonstrate a positive attitude and strong work ethic
- Able to handle multiple priorities and tasks
- Experience with customer service preferred

Working Conditions:

- Able to drive and sit for long periods in all weather conditions
- Able to follow specific directions
- May spend long hours in intense concentration which requires attention to detail and high levels of accuracy
- Required to meet several deadlines which may cause stress
- May need to lift or move heavy objects
- Ability to be under and on top of large trucks while doing truck maintenance
- Potential to bunk in truck occasionally
